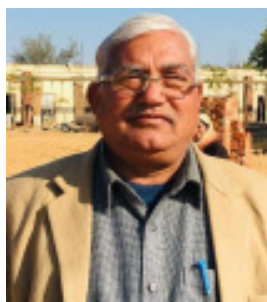

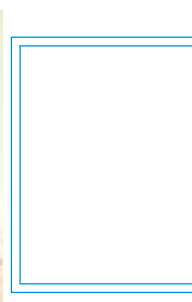

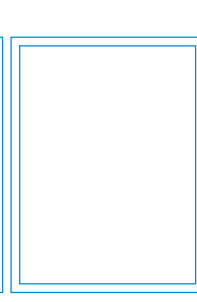

Imagine a sort of pipe coming up from deep down in the earth's surface, passing through the rocks of the earth's crust and coming up to the crater. The lava forces its way up this pipe and overflow to form the sides of the volcano. The Volcanic mountain is therefore found in the areas where the earth's surface is for some reason weak and cannot resist the pressure of the molten lava.

One of the most famous volcanic eruptions of ancient times was of mount Vesuvius near Naples in 78 AD. some neighbouring towns were buried under huge amounts of ash. The ash preserved the bodies of many of the victims which can still be seen today.

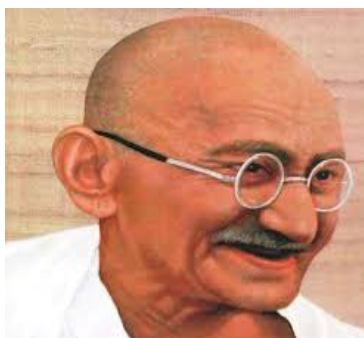
